

Auditors Undergo Performance Audit and State-owned Enterprises (SOE) Workshops



A week-long Performance Audit Refresher Workshop has ended at the General Auditing Commission, GAC.

The workshop, which began on Tuesday, February 16, ended on Wednesday, February 24, 2016, with the Auditor General of Liberia, Madam Yusador S. Gaye, gracing the closing ceremony in the Conference Hall of the Commission. Madam Gaye expressed heartfelt gratitude to the International Facilitator, Ms. Grace M. Nelwamonod for drilling the participants through the various topics.

AG Gaye reminded the performance auditors about the importance of continuous education in the field of auditing. The Auditor General urged them not to leave the workshop and forget about the skills acquired, but to ensure constant application.

She also appreciated the EU for its sponsorship of such skills-sharpening program for Auditors of the Performance Audit Unit of the GAC. The workshop – under the auspices of the GAC Management and sponsorship of the European Union, was intended to further upgrade the skills of the Auditors.

Among topics discussed are Audit Overview and Process Flow; Performance Audit Planning - Part One; Understanding the Entity; Pre-study Plan; Pre-study

Memorandum and System Description, as well as selection of audit problems, among others.
