The financial statements of the Liberia Land Administration Project (LLAP) for period July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 are subject to audit by the Auditor General consistent with the Auditor General's mandate as provided for under Section 2.1.3 of the GAC Act of 2014 as well as the engagement Terms of Reference.

Introduction

The Audit of the LLAP Management for the period July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 has been completed and the purpose of this letter is to bring to your attention the findings that were revealed during the audit.

Scope and Determination of Responsibility

The audit was conducted in accordance with the International Standards of Supreme Audit Institutions (ISSAIs). These standards require that the audit is planned and performed so as to obtain reasonable assurance that, in all material respects, fair presentation is achieved in the annual financial statements.

An audit includes:

- Examination on a test basis of evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements;
- Assessment of the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management; and
- Evaluation of the overall financial statement presentation.

The audit will also include an examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting compliance in all material respects with the relevant laws and regulations which came to our attention and are applicable to financial matters.



The matters mentioned in this letter are therefore those that were identified through tests considered necessary for the purpose of the audit and it is possible that there might be other matters and/or weaknesses that were not identified.

The financial statements, maintenance of effective control measures and compliance with laws and regulations are the responsibility of the Accounting Officer. Our responsibility is to express our opinion on these financial statements.

1 DETAILED FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

1.1 Compliance Issues

1.1.1 Uncompleted Project Deliverables

Observation

- 1.1.1.1 Section I (b) of the Project Financing Agreement states that "The PIU shall be responsible for: (i) ensuring compliance with environmental and social safeguards; (ii) preparing the proposed annual work plans and budgets; (iii) preparing a monthly monitoring table and quarterly progress reports; (iv) monitoring and evaluation of Project activities including the preparation of the baseline studies, social assessment and thematic assessment studies; (v) providing training to the LLA staff; and (vi) such other administrative, financial, technical and organizational arrangements and procedures as may be required for the Project."
- 1.1.1.2 Additionally, Section 3.1 (iii) of the Project Implementation Manual requires the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) to facilitate "effective coordination and implementation of the work plan through regular review meetings with relevant LLA departments. The Project Coordinator will report regularly to the LLA Project Director a staff member appointed by the LLA before the effectiveness of the project, to provide overall coordination of all externally financed projects of the LLA."
- 1.1.1.3 We noted during the conduct of the audit that key deliverables on components of the LLA Project such as the drafting of policies, laws, regulations and administrative procedures relating to land administration in Liberia were not implemented.
- 1.1.1.4 We also noted that the National Geodetic Network and Preparation of Land Survey Standards, consultancy services to pilot the development of land use plans in rural customary communities and the conduct of a baseline survey and land sector reform component were not completed.
- 1.1.1.5 Additionally, there was no evidence that the PIU implemented the renovation of the Liberia Land Authority local offices in line with the project work plan. Refer Appendix 1 for details.

Risk

- 1.1.1.6 Project objectives may not be achieved in the absence of effective project implementation and coordination.
- 1.1.1.7 The absence of effective monitoring and evaluation of project deliverables may deny the achievement of value for money during the execution of the project.

Recommendation

1.1.1.1 Management should ensure that the project deliverables are implemented in line with the project work plan.



1.1.1.2 Management should ensure that proper coordination, monitoring and evaluation of the project are implemented periodically during the execution of the project.

Management's Response

- 1.1.1.3 Noted that the consultancy services for critical regulations, guidelines, and procedures were not completed within the fiscal year of audit. LLA, however, notes that this consultancy is in the latter stage of implementation (completion of regulations) with expected completion by end of April, 2022. The delay in implementation was attributed to conflict between the customary land governance regulations earlier developed by the former USAID-Land Governance Support Activity (LGSA) and the draft regulations developed by the World Bank-hired consultants. Additionally, the review process of the draft took a protracted period of time among LLA, Consultants and the World Bank thereby leading to delay in completion of the consultancy. Another cause for delay was the resurgence of the COVID-19 Delta Variance.
- 1.1.1.4 Noted that the consultancy services for Administrative Procedures were not completed within the fiscal year of audit. LLA, however, notes that these consultancies are currently ongoing with completion of all of the procedures by end of March 2022. Implementation of these consultancies were also hampered by the resurgence of the COVID-19 Delta Variance.
- 1.1.1.5 Noted that there are considerable delays in the implementation of the National Geodetic Network and Preparation of Land Survey Standards. The delays in these two activities were attributed to the delay in their predecessor activities (the Primary Geodetic Network and Continuously Operating Reference Stations -CORS) network. The Primary Geodetic Network is in its advanced stage of implementation while the CORS network has been completed at Fendell Station in Fendell. The completion of these activities paved the way for the implementation of the National Geodetic Network and Preparation of Land Survey Standards, which have already been advertised. These two consultancies are expected to be completed by end of April, 2022. Implementation of the two predecessor activities were hampered by COVID-19 Delta Variance and extended rainy season.
- 1.1.1.6 Noted that there were considerable delays in the implementation of the renovation of the Liberia Land Authority local offices. LLA is making effort to complete this activity in the next fiscal year. The delays were attributed mainly to COVID-19 Delta Variance and the extended rainy season. LLA has completed the procurement process and contractors have been selected for implementation. The County Land Offices (CLOs) renovation will commence in January, 2022 and will be completed by end of April, 2022.

Auditor General's Position

1.1.1.7 We acknowledge Management's assertion that ". LLA is making effort to complete this activity in the next fiscal year. The delays were attributed mainly to COVID-19 Delta



Variance and the extended rainy season." we will make follow-up on deliverables during subsequent audit.

1.1.1.8 However, we maintain our findings and recommendations.
