Opinion

We have audited the financial statements of Tree Crop Extension Project (TCEP) II, which comprise the statement of Receipts and Payments, and the statement of Comparison of Budget and Actual Amounts and Accompanying notes to the financial statements for the period then ended.

In our opinion, the accompanying financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, and its financial performance from the Project effective date to June 30, 2021 in accordance with International Public Sector Accounting Standards (IPSAS 2017) Cash Basis of Accounting.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards of Supreme Audit Institutions (ISSAIs). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the International Fund for Agriculture Development (IFAD) Project Implementing Unit (PIU) of the Ministry of Agriculture (MoA) in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements in Liberia, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Key Audit Matters

Key audit matters are those matters that, in our professional judgment, were of most significance in our audit of the financial statements of the current period. These matters were addressed in the context of our audit of the financial statements as a whole, and in forming our opinion thereon, and we do not provide a separate opinion on these matters. We have determined that there are no key audit matters to communicate in our report.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION ON THE PROJECT

The total cost of the TCEP II is USD 33.477 million financed from an IFAD highly concessional loan of USD 11.913million, IFAD additional grant of 11.913million, contributions (in-Kind) from a Private Partner (USD3.381million), Beneficiaries (USD1.783million), the GoL (USD 2.487million) and a Financing Gap of US\$2.0 million. The agreement to finance the USD2.0million has been signed by IFAD and the government of Liberia in Loan of USD1.46million and a grant of USD 0.54million awaiting ratification. The TCEP II financing agreement was signed on March 23, 2019; ratified by the Government of Liberia and became effective in September 2019.

The project consists of four (4) components, namely:

<u>Component 1: Revitalization of Cocoa Plantation</u> - The expected outcome of Component 1 is to "increased quantity and quality of cocoa sold by smallholders". Revitalization and replanting of cocoa will take place between project year (PY) 1 to PY4 with development of the value chain linkages. Young trees will only produce from year 2 or 3 and not fully mature for possibly 5 years. The scope to realize a "full" harvest will be limited to 3years or 3 cycles of planting within the project duration, a difficulty always faced when dealing with tree crop activities. Additional focus on crop husbandry and post-harvest handling will be undertaken throughout the project. The project will sponsor and adopt a phased approach, rehabilitating and replanting a 0.25 ha per farm per year for the first 4 years. Farmers would receive incremental support beyond the initial quarter hectare, based on a number of criteria including compliance with good agronomic practices and labour provision requirements.

<u>Component 2: Rehabilitation and Maintenance of Existing Farm-to-Market Roads</u> - This component aims at providing climate resilient road infrastructure that will be supportive of the development of the cocoa value chain in the project area. The expected outcome would be "improved access to markets and reduced transportation costs".

<u>Component 3: Capacity Building for Service Provision</u> - Component 3 concerns value chain development especially regarding player relations and service provision. The expected outcome of Component 3 is to: "improved service provision to cocoa farmers for value chain development". This will be achieved through five concurrent activities namely:(a) Strengthening the capacity of cocoa farmers at community (through Farmer Field Schools (FFSs)/FBOs) and district levels (Cooperatives); (b) Support for better "linkages" between all cocoa market producers, buyers and exporters; (c) Support to public and private service providers through MoA, the County Agricultural Coordinator (CAC) and District Agricultural Offices (DAOs) and the Liberia Agriculture Commodity Regulatory Authority (LACRA); (d) Support for improved Policy Dialogue; and (e) Monitoring of deforestation in the cocoa sector.

<u>Component 4: Project Coordination Management and M&E</u> - Both TCEP II and TCEP I will be harmonized so that there is effectively one Tree Crops Extension Project in Liberia. Both will be able to take advantage of the newly ratified Rural Community Finance Project (RCFP). One country programme management team will implement all IFAD funded operations for economies of scale, synergy and consistency. From a programmatic point of view this increases efficiency and resource use, harmonizes the approach to tree crop development and allows a focus of the PIU on one project but implemented across two counties. Component 4 will be implemented through two sub-components.



Subcomponent 4.1 - Project coordination and management. The implementation of TCEP II will be carried out through the PIU and provide staff, vehicles, office equipment and supplies, as well as operational costs. Staffing levels within the PIU will be complemented with technical assistance as needed, including those for thematic studies and areas such as Gender and Social inclusion, M&E, Value Chain Development for facilitating the multi-stakeholder platform and ultimately brokering relationships and dealing with commercial contractual arrangements (possibilities of linkages with organizations such as World Cocoa Foundation, Mars and the Rainforest Alliance will be explored). At the county level, support will be provided for operational costs, including for the supervision of project activities, alignment of TCEP II activities with those of TCEP I, monitoring of project activities and reports on any rendition. The project will provide short training courses and workshops (one per staff per year) to enhance the implementation capacity of the various cadres of staff at the national and County offices.

Subcomponent 4.2 - Policy dialogue and influence, this subcomponent seeks to influence policy in the interests of smallholder farmers and the rural poor that will participate not only under TCEP II but also under TCEP I. Areas to focus on will include: (a) sustainability of road maintenance, particularly through engagement with the Ministry of Public Works and the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning; (b) mainstreaming gender and youth, which will involve engagement with the Ministry of Gender, Children & Social Protection and the Ministry of Youth and Sport, and which will culminate into the development of a Gender and Youth Strategy; (c) climate-friendly cocoa, involving engagement with the Environment Protection Agency and the Ministry of Agriculture; and (d) the potential expansion of cocoa production with the Ministry of Agriculture and other partners. The Project Coordinator will be responsible for coordinating this effort with support from the Gender Officer, Environmental Officer and Tree Crop Officer. Technical Assistance will be sought, as needed, to facilitate the different dialogues.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE

The goal of TCEP II is to "increase income and improve the livelihoods of poor rural households farming cocoa on a smallholder basis in Lofa". The Project Development Objective of TCEP II is to improve incomes and climate resilience of smallholder cocoa producers in Lofa County. It will do this in concert with TCEP I which covers Nimba county. The main outcomes and outputs of the project include: (i) Enhanced and more resilient incomes and reduced rural poverty in project areas; (ii) Improved value chain organization and performance; (iii) Improved access to markets, processing and storage facilities for cocoa; (iv) Kilometres of road climate-proofed, rehabilitated or upgraded; (v) Increased Forest sink potential; and (vi) Improved access to sustainable fuel energy.

During the period ended June 30, 2021, the project received a cash total of US\$ 3,307,598.15(\$1,598,884.47 IFAD Loan and \$1,708,713.68 IFAD Grant) available in cash for implementation of planned activities. This Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWPB) for the period was projected at US\$4,633,097.25 (Four Million Six Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Ninety-Seven United Stated Dollars 25/100) out of which US15,898.40 was projected as Beneficiary contribution.

Actual expenditure of US\$1,738,101.01 was incurred by the project during the reporting period for implementation including amongst other things; procurement of equipment and Inputs, Consultancy, Training and workshop, staff salary payment and operating activities.

The budget for Civil Works included projection for award of 60.45 farm to market roads. Contracts for the 60.45km roads were not awarded as planned due to information received from IFAD during the early part of the year, placing CAP on disbursement to projects. In addition, the variance in the civil works category also account for ongoing works contracts that were not executed as planned thereby delaying disbursement towards works contracts.

The low execution rate in the Category for Goods, services and Inputs reflect the fact that procurement of farming tools fertilizers, cassava cuttings and other inputs as well as the procurement of two mini trucks were completed and funds committed. However, delivery was delay as a result of disruption in worldwide shipment due to Covid-19 Pandemic. The procurement of cocoa hybrid seeds another major component of this category was done; the seeds were delivered and waiting germination result as condition for payment.

The negative variances in Salaries and allowances and operating cost are due to expenses incurred from March to June 30, 2020(project start-up) that and captured 2020/2021 budget year.
